Foundation celebrates scholarship donors, winners

NEWARK — Lenise Sunnenberg knows what it's like to choose between paying her bills and buying her books for next semester.

She knows what it's like to be a single mom, struggling to find time for schoolwork.

That's why, to Sunnenberg, the value of the Licking County Foundation's scholarship program is immeasurable.

"The question is: 'How on earth does a single parent — and starving artist — afford to go to school?' "she said. "And that's where you come in. ... I cannot begin to express how much this scholarship makes a difference in my life."

Sunnenberg was one of 327 area students honored Monday during the LCF's second scholarship awards celebration and reception.

The LCF had a record number of applicants this year — 727 — and it also gave away a record amount of money — \$730,088 to the 327 students honored Monday and \$65,500, which will be awarded in the future to Ohio State University-Newark and Central Ohio Technical College students.

LCF has been awarding scholarships since 1968, but this is only the second year for the awards celebration, director Connie Hawk said.

"Philanthropy inspires philanthropy," Hawk said, and the ceremony is a chance to "just really celebrate the generosity of this community and the young people who are the future of this community."

The scholarships are provided each year through various community funds, and several of the fund backers spoke Monday about what inspired them to give.

Christopher Meyer spoke on behalf of the James W. Pyle Memorial Scholarship. Meyer and Pyle were attorneys in the same law firm for 20-plus years, and Pyle was an oxymoron, Meyer said: "a humble attorney."

Pyle always tried to do right, and he pushed others to do the same, Meyer said.

"It's fitting that we honor his memory through a scholarship," he said. "That way, he continues his unselfish ways of helping deserving people that he never met."

Geraldine Marston spoke about her husband, who wanted so badly to go to college that he joined the United States Air Force to take advantage of the GI Bill, which paid for veterans to go to school.

Later in life, Geraldine and her husband often talked about how important a college degree was to his success. They talked to their attorney — who happened to be James Pyle — and created an estate plan that would establish a scholarship after their deaths.

When Larry died, though, Geraldine decided she didn't want to wait to honor his memory, so she set up the scholarship fund through the LCF.

"Larry knew from his experience that the college degree was a key to his success in life," she said. "The scholarships are very small in comparison to the cost of a college education today, but I think it's also important to the recipients to know that someone cares enough about you to invest in your future."

Several of the LCF winners are second-, third- or even fourth-time scholarship recipients. That's important because, although plenty of scholarships are available to college freshman, the bill doesn't get any smaller for sophomores, juniors and seniors, said Kelly Roberts, a fourth-year recipient.

"Your sophomore year, you're lucky to find any outside scholarship that you qualify for," Roberts said, making the LCF scholarships "a saving grace for upperclassmen."

"The Licking Community Foundation scholarships have been a huge blessing to me and my family," she said. "I'm thankful I've been able to grow up in such a caring and generous community, and it makes me proud to call Licking County my home."
