Grants ... Strengthening our Community

Our donors believe that having strong nonprofit organizations and supporting the services they provide are integral to Licking County's vitality. The Foundation is home to 300 philanthropic funds which are used in a variety of ways to provide support for nonprofit organizations with grants. In partnership with donors, we distributed \$2.9 million in grants across a broad range of programs in 2021. Discretionary grants—from field of interest funds that support causes selected by the donor, and from unrestricted funds—are approved by the Foundation's Governing Committee to support specific charities. Donors also provide grant funding directly to organizations through agency, designated agency, project, donor advised and community charitable funds. The Foundation strives to support both our donors and our nonprofit partners as we work together to strengthen the community.

Strategic Grant Program

As a result of intentional and frequent engagement with our nonprofit community that began during the COVID-19 pandemic, LCF continuously gains new insights into how different organizations of many shapes and sizes are meeting a broad and complex array of needs across all the communities in Licking County. Awarded as one-year and multiple-year discretionary grants, this strategic support helps area nonprofits meet the ever-changing needs of our community.

Generally, LCF strategic grants are focused on projects or programs that:

- Help launch new projects which represent a unique and unduplicated opportunity for the community
- Support established organizations for special purposes
- · Support organizations which deliver effective existing programs to assist or empower underserved or disadvantaged populations
- · Offer new approaches to solving problems and stimulate others to participate in problem-solving
- · Create opportunities for organizations to collaborate without duplicating services, and leverage additional resources
- Make a clear difference in the quality of life for a substantial number of people
- · Propose innovative, creative and practical solutions to both current and emerging community needs
- Strengthen an agency's effectiveness or stability
- Generate matching funds
